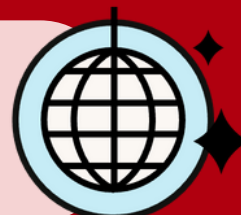

## **WHAT IS A WORKSHOP?**

Our music theatre workshops are developmental sessions where you will learn processes and techniques to improve your artist practice. They are led by industry professionals and delve deeper than a regular rehearsal, aiming to give you a toolkit of skills to level up your performances.

## **WHEN ARE THE WORKSHOPS?**

Our five-week project period is from 28th October until show day on 1st December. You and your castmate will be given a personalised schedule based on your availability in those weeks.

## **DO I HAVE TO HAVE A CASTMATE?**

Our unique model celebrates the creativity of two (or more) performers shining together as they explore different sides and perspectives of the same character/performance. For this project, you will be collaborating with a castmate both on and off the stage.

## **DOES EVERYONE GET IN?**

There is an application process for this project and no guarantee that everyone will get in. This is based on availability and suitability for this particular program. However, if you are not selected for this project, we offer other programs throughout the year.

## **WHERE ARE WORKSHOPS HELD?**

Our programs are usually held in the south east suburbs of Melbourne. For this project, we also have online modules to support your progress between sessions.

## **DO I NEED TO BRING A SUPPORT WORKER?**

Thanks to the castmate model, where 2 performers share a role, and the support of our experienced inclusion team, all support needs will be met!

If we are unable to find a suitable castmate match, we may ask you to bring a support worker to ensure you can participate in the series fully.

## **WHAT IF MY AVAILABILITY CHANGES OR I MISS A SESSION?**

It is important for you to give accurate availability on your application form. In the unfortunate case you must miss a workshop, your session may have to be rescheduled. It will be at the discretion of the creative team to decide whether the number can still go ahead.

## **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

For artists receiving support, there is a fee involved in participation in this series. It is Stars and the Moon's policy that no one should miss out on the experience due to financial difficulty. There may also be roles available for performers not providing or receiving support on a case by case basis, and there will be a small show fee in that instance.
