### Cast Expectations:

- Attend all rehearsals and shows. If you have any planned unavailabilities, please let us know in advance when booking your audition so we can consider them when scheduling.
- Be punctual and proactively communicate any unexpected unavailabilities at the earliest opportunity. Performers who are late by more than 15 minutes or absent from rehearsal three times without prior notice will be required to meet with the Production Manager to review their participation in the show.
- Help your castmate with learning and practicing choreography, lines, blocking and lyrics within rehearsal time.
- Behave respectfully and use appropriate communication with cast and crew.

You are not expected to assist your castmate with personal care, medical or behavioral needs. These matters will be handled by our team of highly experienced support staff.
